ANNUAL MISSION APPEAL The Missionary Sisters of St. Peter Claver will be here on 21st/22nd of April to appeal on behalf of the Sisters Missions Committee of England & Wales. They will tell us about their missionary work and will be grateful for your support.

Next weekend is Good Shepherd Sunday, the day we pray for priests and for vocations to the priesthood. The annual collection for the Priest Training Fund will also take place the following weekend (28th/29th). This fund pays for the priestly formation of men for the Catholic priesthood. There are currently 45 men studying at Allen Hall seminary, 28 of whom are for our own Diocese, and last year eight men ordained to the priesthood to serve as our future priests.
