EU SETTLEMENT SCHEME The government will soon launch the EU Settlement Scheme, offering EU citizens living here a legal route to remain. EU citizens must apply if they are to protect their existing rights and their place in our society. We expect that some people, particularly those who are already vulnerable, may face difficulties in practically accessing the scheme, leaving their immigration status at risk. Therefore, the Bishops of England and Wales have asked that parishes, schools and organisations bring the Settlement Scheme to the attention of all who need to avail themselves of it, and to be aware of vulnerable people who may face barriers to applying or who do not realise that they need to apply. In particular, they encourage you to signpost people towards the official information on the Settlement Scheme: gov.uk/settled-status-eu-citizens-families
